PACE OF PLAY

- A Marshal will greet and welcome each group.
- Marshals will always work backward through the golf course.
- Marshals will warn any group that is approximately one or more holes behind the group ahead.
- The Marshal will continue a reverse loop around the golf course. The slow group will have that time to catch the group in front of them. The group may be asked to skip a hole and move into position on the course.
- Please remember – 18 holes of golf should take 4 hours or less to play (regardless of ability). Please keep up so everyone behind you can enjoy their day.
- Your cooperation is appreciated to keep golf enjoyable for everyone.

Reservations are accepted in person or by phone a maximum of seven days in advance; i.e., Saturday for Saturday play. Internet reservations are accepted up to 10 days in advance of play.

Reservations for tee times are accepted for one to four players. A single may make a reservation in person or by phone only. Foursomes will be filled before starting play whenever possible.

On Saturday, Sunday and holidays, May through August, 9-hole reservations are limited to approximately the first hour of the day and after 1:00 p.m. Golfers who wish to reserve a 9-hole tee time between approximately 7:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. may be charged the 18-hole rate.
